a. Language b. Money c. Work d. Communication e. School


f. Culture g. Others

First, I asked problems in living in Japan and what can Japanese people do to solve this problem

at question 1 and 2.



Result of question 1 and 2, "Communication" is the most votes.

What stood out here was the passivity of Japanese of many Japanese people in Japan can guess what people nearby think. It is good thing, but when they contact with foreigners, it will become a barrier difficult to communicate. According to the survey, I understood there are possibility that foreigner feel left out cause of lack of communication. The result of communication vote are much than languages vote, I consider finding what was a problem cause for an obstacle to communication. ## Debate

- Debate is a way of thinking about one's opinion.
- Children and adults should be thaught how to express themselves and be rocal about any problems they may have.

Study abroad or outside school hours

- Interviewing people about current events through international staff like ALT or special events.
- Class trips abroad are also most effective on givving experience.
- If people want to study abroad, it's also really helpful for the future.

The result can be roughly classified into two kinds like "debate" and "study abroad and outside school hours." First category is debate.

Taking these results, I think about content of cross- cultural understanding class concretely. In addition, I focus on two purposes and examine them. Firstly, Improving the passivity of Japanese to motivate saying own opinion willingly. Secondly, Coming into contact with a different culture. To achieve first purpose, I suggests adopting debate in this class. By saying own opinion directly, students may become less passive. Through saying an opinion not just for ourselves, but for some position. It's connect more cross-cultural understanding.

To achieve second purpose, I suggest a school trip to a foreign country. By coming into contact with foreign culture directly, we will be able to learn many things.

There are many problems for foreigner's school life besides languages. So, it's important for Japanese students to bring assertiveness and deepen one's understanding of different culture to support foreigner's school life.
